On Parent Feedback (2016-17)**

Report is generated as follows based on the observations noted in the written feedback collected from the parents during the parent-teachers meet organized on dated 27/12/2016. Abstract of the observations and the suggestions is as follows:

A. General observations:

1. Institution ranked high from among the other institutions in the Pauni Taluka.
2. Physical facilities have been appreciated with desire for enhancement.
3. Discipline maintained and the safety of the students in the college campus appreciated.
4. Regular communication on students' performance by the college is commendable.
5. Teaching-learning methodology has been found to be most suited to the students of rural areas.
6. No complaint received about the fee structure that falls within the norms of affiliating university and state government.
7. Partially satisfied with the games and sports activities as well as the ongoing skill based courses. However, positively responded on the teaching-learning and evaluation method developed by the institution.

B. Constructive suggestions:


- Expected to enhance infrastructure and other physical facilities
- So as to avoid the academic loss of the students, urgently required to fill the vacant posts.
- Expected the provision for free access of internet facilities to the students
- Received suggestion for spacious library and enhancement in games and sports activities


C. Recommendations:


Based on the observations and the constructive suggestion obtained, the committee strongly suggest to work on following aspects immediately.

1. Spacious laboratories to be made available
2. Library facilities need to be enhanced by incorporating journals and curriculum based reference and text books
3. Frequent organization of games and sports events
4. Vacant posts needs to be fulfilled on priority basis
5. Free access of internet to be made available to the students.



Obtained feedback from the parents during the meeting held on 27 Dec.2017 in written format has been analysed by the committee and arrived at following conclusions.

A. General observations:

3. Preparation and submission of the proposal for filling vacant posts
4. Submission for the initiation of new and skill based short term courses
5. Free access of the internet and other online facilities to the student

B. Constructive suggestions:


- Need for initiation of more number skill based courses

4. Immediate action to be taken on filling vacant posts.



B. suggestions:


- ❖ Augmentation of laboratories in terms of space expected
