B) All applications for admission must be made in the prescribed format supplied along with the prospectus obtained from the college on payment of Rs. 100/- in cash or by crossed postal order payable to the Principal, Science College, Pauni Dist. Bhandara. If the application is desired to be send by registered post, a self-addressed envelope of size 9" x 4" bearing postal stamps worth Rs. 6/- must accompany requisition for the form.

C) Every application must be attested by the Father or Guardian of the candidate who will be responsible for him/ her.

D) Every applicant will have to pay Rs. 100/- as the registration fee (non refundable) while submission of application form. This should be paid in cash at the college counter and official receipt be obtained. Application form from outside Pauni should be send by registered post accompanied by the cross postal order for the Rs100/- as the registration fee payable to the Principal, Science college, Pauni Dist. Bhandara.

- vi) Two copied of the Passport size 2"x2" recent photograph of the applicant of be affixed one each on the application form & Identity /Admission Card. The original of these documents must be produced at the time interview / admission.
- F) Selected candidates will be sent interview cards and the list of such candidates will be put on the college notice board. The college does not takes responsibility for the delay in receipt of the interview card by candidate or loss there of in transit. The candidate will have to prepare for interview before the admission board at their own cost on a day fixed for the some along with all necessary documents in original. ► **10. PHYSICAL EFFICIENCY TEST** ►

All students on the role of the college shall present themselves for physical efficiency test before the board of examiners on such date and time as may be fixed by the principal. Physical Efficiency test shall be conducted in the month of January/ February every year.

Candidate successful at the physical efficiency test, shall be placed in grade A and B and receive certificate signed by the principal. Incentive marks will be awarded to active participates in the intercollegiate tournaments. Attendance 80% must in the regular physical education practical lecture. If a student fails to appear at the physical efficiency test, he/she shall be fined Rs. 50/-

► **11. MEDICAL EXAMINATION** ►

a) Every degree college student on the rolls of college must presents for medical inspection before the medical board appointed by the college. The medical examination is compulsory for all degree college students. The timetable of this examination will be put up on the notice board.

► **COLLEGE EXAMINATION** ►

The home examination, unit test, terminal and test of the college will be held on the dates fixed by the college council. Every student must appear at all the examinations. Absentees without prior permission will have to pay a fine of Rs.50/- per paper.

Students securing marks less than 20% will be fined Rs.10/- for per paper.

The following Categories of the student may get exemption as per the rules made by the college council.

- i) Students appearing at the winter examination of Nagpur University on production of proof to that effect before the commencement of the home examination.
- ii) Student who, on medical ground requests exemption should

produce a medical certificate from any one of the medical officers appointed by the college.

- iii) Any other ground which in the opinion of the principal enables the student to claim exemption.

► 9. ATTENDANCE ►

A) In order to qualify, as candidate for university examination, every student as per rule, must attend not less than 75% of the lectures and he particulars delivered in every month in each of their subjects of study. It will entirely be the responsibility of the student to keep regular attendance. If the attendance in any quarter is short, the name of such defaulter may be removed from the role and E.B.C. list and such student will have to pay full tuition fees to the college for the subsequent quarters also and he/she will not be entitled for free ship at all.

B) A fine of 50 paisa per period will be imposed on the student who absent himself from the college without leaves application. Absence at the tutorial classes will entail a fine of Rs. 1/- per period.

C) Application submitted for the purpose of leave should be countersigned by the father or guardian. Medical leave application should be accompanied by a medical certificate.

D) Leave of absence will be entirely at the student's own risk and certificate of any kind will not condone a deficiency in attendance required by the university.

E) All students including scheduled cast. Scheduled tribes, VJ, NT etc. and economically backward classes getting scholarship or free studentship or free ship should note that their scholarship or free ship will entirely depend on their regular attendance which should not be less than 75% and satisfactory progress as evidence by passing all unit/monthly tests and tests examination of the college. If students belonging to aforesaid categories failed to put in 75% attendance in any month, they will have to pay fees for that month irrespective of the ground of absence.

i) Students who failed to put in 75% attendance at lectures and practical classes at the end of session will be detained and will not be

allowed to take the university examination irrespective of the grounds of short attendance, as per para 6-A (i) of ordinance 6 of the Nagpur University for degree students.

The A.T.K.T. students should not that the above conditions of 75% attendance are also application to them.

► 5. PAYMENT OF FEES ►

1. The first installment of tuition fees is to be paid at the time of admission.
2. If second installment not paid by 15th Dec. a fine of 50 paisa will be imposed for every day of delay.
3. If payment is not made till the end of December the name of defaulter may be struck of the college rolls nevertheless he/ she shall be liable to pay the fee for whole session.
4. A student thus removed may be readmitted if he/she pays all arrears with fines together with Rs.50/- as the Readmission Fees.
5. Students, who cancel admission any time after admission for Any reason, shall have to pay tuition & other fees for whole session.
6. No certificate for any kind will be issued unless full Session fees are paid. Any amount paid by him/her at the time of admission for later will not be refunded at all.

► 6. REFUND OF FEES ►

A) Caution money / Laboratory deposit

- 1) Caution money will be refunded to every student after deduction Rs. 5/- towards breakage, depreciation and wear of furniture and other equipment.
- 2) Students will have to apply for refund of caution money and library deposit on or before 15th November of the session to be latest after which they will not be entitled for refund.
- 3) Refund of caution Money will began in every year September.

- 4) Caution Money will not be refunded to the student so long as he does not clear college dues in full.

B) Library Deposit

This will be refund to the student from 1st Sep. to 15th Nov.

► 7. ENROLMENT ►

All students who are new entrants will have to enroll themselves in the University.

A prescribed form for this purpose will be supplied by the college in due courses for time or by 10th Sep. of the session to be the latest. A fine of Rs. 50/- is imposed by the University if the enrolment form along with the enrolment fees does not reach the University by 15th Sep. of the session.

► 8. CONCESSION ►

A) The Government of India Post scholarship to the B.C. Students (SC/ST/NT/VJ etc.)

- i) All the backward class students (SC/ ST/ NT/ VJ etc) undertaking approved post H.S.S.C. Courses are considered eligible for the government of India Scholarship as per Government Rule.
- ii) Refundable fees and other fees not reimbursed by the government will have to pay by the students.
- iii) The scholarship will be paid to the students according to the Government Rule.

iv) Other Conditions for the Award :

The Scholarship is dependent on the satisfactory progress regular attendance and conduct of scholar. If its is reported by the head of institute that a scholar has by reasons of his/ her own act or default failed to show satisfactory progress or has been guilty of clarity in attendance the authority may cancel the scholarship or stop or withhold further payments.

V) Procedure of submission of form for the scholarship

- a) All backward class students and coming under lower income group should apply for the Government of India Scholarship in the prescribed form to the college office in the month of June-July only. The application forms will be made available to them at the time of

admission Students should be vigilant enough to fill in the form correctly and completely in all respects, false information shall disqualify him/her form the above scholarship.

- b)The students having a gap in education should invariably file a court affidavit declaring as to what he/she was doing during the intervening period.

- c) The students who were in receipt of Government of India Scholarship last year and have passed the annual examination OR in A.T.K.T. are also require to submit the application Social Welfare Officer, Bhandara by the college for the renewal of Scholarship.
- d) For other details contact the college office, or refer the regulations government the award..
- B) Economically Backward Classes (E.B.C.) those whose annual income is less than 1,00,000/- are declared economically backward. Their fees are reimbursed by the State Government. However the student have to apply in the prescribed form (to be obtained from the college office). Together with income certificate signed by revenue officer not below the rank of Tahsildar and attested true copy of mark sheet of the last examination immediately after he/she is admitted to the college.
- i) E.B.C. Concession shall be decided at the end of session on the regular attendance, which should not be less than 75% and satisfactory progress in a monthly unit test and test examination.

Note :- If the E.B.C. Form is rejected by the competent authority the students shall have to pay full fees before the examination.

C) Once failure concession

A students belonging to the schedule cast, schedule tribes, navaboudha, V.J. and NT etc. who failed only ones is also entitled to reimbursement of fees provided he/she produced sufficient proof for such failure and fill in the prescribed form for the free ship at the time of admission to the college.

D) Concession to the children, wives & widows of the defense person.

Students whose father is serving in armed forces OR who is retired

from defense service is eligible for free studentship on the production

E) Concession to the children of Primary / middle school teacher.
