HISTORY

Shri Shivaji Education Society, Amravati is the foundation society, which manage this college. Shri Shivaji Education Society is founded by Dr. Panjabrao Alias Bhausaheb Deshmukh was established in 1932 at Amravati. Now society is managing more than 275 institutions of different faculties including senior colleges, Jr. Colleges, Secondary schools, Hostels, Engineering colleges, Polytechnic colleges, Medical colleges, etc.

Shri. Shivaji Education Society, Amravati has started Science College at Pauni, Dist-Bhandara from the year 1988–89 with the enrolment of the Students in B.Sc. – I (Maths).

The session 2019–2020 will commence on 15th June 2019 ended on 30th April, 2020. The college meets in one shift from 10.30 A.M. to 5.30 P.M. The college posses its own building since 2001.

The college has two storied building situated on Khapri Road, Pauni. The massive two-storied building includes Five Science Laboratories, Five Classrooms, Principal Room, Administrative block Library, Girls Common Room, Computer Science Lab, Staff Room, etc.

The college from 2001 is under UGC norms and has 12B & 2(f). The College also faced NAAC and Re-accredited at B level.

1. ADMISSION

- A) The college will re-open on 15th June for the session 2019-2020. The Teaching will commence from 15th June. During the session the admission will be open to

B.Sc. Sem-I, III and V	Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology & Computer Science.
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Note: English & Marathi are compulsory subjects for B.Sc.-Sem I & II.

- B) All applications for admission must be made in the prescribed format supplied along with the prospectus obtained from the college on payment of Rs. 20/- in cash or by crossed postal order payable to the Principal, Science College, Pauni Dist. Bhandara. If the application is desired to be send by registered post, a self-addressed envelope of size 9" x 4" bearing postal stamps worth Rs. 6/- must accompany requisition for the form.
- C) Every application must be attested by the Father or Guardian of the candidate who will be responsible for him/ her.
- D) Every applicant will have to pay Rs. 100/- as the registration fee (non refundable) while submission of application form. This should be paid in cash at the college counter and official receipt be obtained. Application form from outside Pauni should be send by registered post accompanied by the cross postal order for the Rs100/- as the registration fee payable to the Principal, Science college, Pauni Dist. Bhandara.
- School / College Leaving Certificate signed by the headmaster/ Principal of the school / college in which candidate studied last. (This original Certificate will not be returned in any case after admission).
 - A copy of statement of marks last exam passed/ failed. Student should be taken back the original statement of marks after verification.
 - Character Certificate signed by the head of institution last attended.
 - A certificate of good conduct of responsible citizen in case of student who appeared at the last examination as private candidate.

- v) Migration certificate in case of student who have passed last exam from the university other than Nagpur University of Board other than Nagpur Divisional Board of Secondary Education. (This certificate has to reach the University Office by the 1st. Oct. of the year filling with a fine of Rs. 10/- is imposed by the University).
- vi) Two copied of the Passport size 2"x2" recent photograph of the applicant of be affixed one each on the application form & Identity/Admission Card. The original of these documents must be produced at the time interview /admission.
- F) Selected candidates will be sent interview cards and the list of such candidates will be put on the college notice board. The college does not takes responsibility for the delay in receipt of the interview card by candidate or loss there of in transit. The candidate will have to prepare for interview before the admission board at their own cost on a day fixed for the some along with all necessary documents in original. However interview does not guarantee admission to college. The candidate should be affix on rupee stamp to the interview card and clearly write his / her name and address on it at the time of submitting the application form.
- G) The selected candidates will have to pay all fees within the prescribed date. In case a student does not deposit fees by the above date his/her admission will stand to cancel.
- H) A student will issue an identity – admission card by the counter clerk on payment of college admission dues and fees. Immediately after this the student shall submit it to the Principal for this signature.
- I) Admission will be regarded as provisional and liable for cancellation at any time if the student fails to obtain the signature of the principal on the Identity / Admission Card.
- J) The following application for admission will not be considered.
- i) Application, which is not made in prescribed form or the form that is not filled properly and carefully.
 - ii) Application, which is not accompanied by the certificates required under Para (V) Admission.
 - iii) Application in respect of which the registration fees of Rs. 20/- is not paid
- K) The decision of the principal in regards to th`e admission will be final.

2. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

B.Sc. Semester - I

Students who has passed H.S.S.C. (XII Std.) of the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary Education or any other examination equivalent which is prescribed by RTMU Nagpur

B.Sc. Semester - III

Students who have passed B.Sc. Sem. I & II Examination of the Nagpur University or 1/3 Subject of B.Sc.- Sem. I & II in examination recognized equivalent.

B.Sc. Semester - V

Students must pass B.Sc. Sem. I, II, III & IV Examination of the Nagpur University and as per RTMU Nagpur University.

Note:- Admission to all classes is subject to availability of seats as per university rule.

5. PAYMENT OF FEES

1. The first installment of tuition fees is to be paid at the time of admission.
2. If second installment not paid by 15th Dec. a fine of 50 paisa will be imposed for every day of delay.
3. December the name of defaulter may be struck of the college rolls nevertheless he/ she shall be liable to pay the fee for whole session.
4. A student thus removed may be readmitted if he/she pays all arrears with fines together with Rs.50/- as the Readmission Fees.
5. Students, who cancel admission any time after admission for any reason, shall have to pay tuition & other fees for whole session.
6. No certificate for any kind will be issued unless full Session fees are paid. Any amount paid by him/her at the time of admission for later will not be refunded at all.

6. REFUND OF FEES

A) Caution money / Laboratory deposit

- 1) Caution money will be refunded to every student after deduction Rs. 5/- towards breakage, depreciation and wear of furniture and other equipment.
- 2) Students will have to apply for refund of caution money and library deposit on or before 15th November of the session to be latest after which they will not be entitled for refund.
- 3) Refund of caution Money will began in every year September.
- 4) Caution Money will not be refunded to the student so long as he does not clear college dues in full.

B) Library Deposit

This will be refund to the student from 1st Sep. to 15th Nov.

7. ENROLMENT

All students who are new entrants will have to enroll themselves in the University.

A prescribed form for this purpose will be supplied by the college in due courses for time or by 10th Sep. of the session to be the latest. A fine of Rs. 50/- is imposed by the University if the enrolment form along with the enrolment fees does not reach the University by 15th Sep. of the session.

8. CONCESSION

A) The Government of India Post scholarship to the B.C. Students (SC/ST/NT/VJ etc.)

i) All the backward class students (SC/ ST/ NT/ VJ etc) undertaking approved post H.S.S.C. Courses are considered eligible for the government of India Scholarship as per Government Rule.

ii) Refundable fees and other fees not reimbursed by the government will have to pay by the students.

iii) The scholarship will be paid to the students according to the Government Rule.

iv) Other Conditions for the Award:

The Scholarship is dependent on the satisfactory progress regular attendance and conduct of scholar. If its is reported by the head of institute that a scholar has by reasons of his/ her own act or default failed to show satisfactory progress or has been guilty of clarity in attendance the authority may cancel the scholarship or stop or withhold further payments.

v) Procedure of submission of form for the scholarship

a) All backward class students and coming under lower income group should apply for the Government of India Scholarship in the prescribed form to the college office in the month of June-July only. The application forms will be made available to them at the time of admission Students should be vigilant enough to fill in the form correctly and completely in all respects, false information shall disqualify him/her from the above scholarship.

b) The students having a gap in education should invariably file a court affidavit declaring as to what he/she was doing during the intervening period.

- c) The students who were in receipt of Government of India Scholarship last year and have passed the annual examination OR in A.T.K.T. are also require to submit the application to Social Welfare Officer, Bhandara by the college for the renewal of Scholarship.
- d) For other details contact the college office, or refer the regulations government the award.

B) Economically Backward Classes (E.B.C.) those whose income is less than 1,00,000/- are declared economically backward. Their fees are reimbursed by the State Government. However the student have to apply in the prescribed form (to be obtained from the college office). Together with income certificate signed by revenue officer not below the rank of Tahsildar and attested true copy of mark sheet of the last examination immediately after he/she is admitted to the college.

- i) E.B.C. Concession shall be decided at the end of session on the regular attendance, which should not be less than 75% and satisfactory progress in a monthly unit test and test examination.

Note:- If the E.B.C. Form is rejected by the competent authority the students shall have to pay full fees before the examination.

C) Once failure concession

A students belonging to the schedule cast, schedule tribes, navaboudha, V.J. and NT etc. who failed only ones is also entitled to reimbursement of fees provided he/she produced sufficient proof for such failure and fill in the prescribed form for the free ship at the time of admission to the college.

D) Concession to the children, wives & widows of the defense person.

A student whose father is serving in armed forces OR who is retired from defense service is eligible for free studentship on the production.

E) Concession to the children of Primary / middle school teacher.

9. ATTENDANCE

- A)** In order to qualify, as candidate for university examination, every student as per rule, must attend not less than 75% of the lectures and he particulars delivered in every month in each of their subjects of study. It will entirely be the responsibility of the student to keep regular attendance. If the attendance in any quarter is short, the name of such of defaulter may be removed from the role and E.B.C. list and such student will have to pay full tuition fees to the college for the subsequent quarters also and he/she will not be entitled for free ship at all.
- B)** A fine of 50 paisa per period will be imposed on the students who absent himself from the college without leaves application. Absence at the tutorial classes will entail a fine of Rs. 1/- per period.
- C)** Application submitted for the purpose of leave should be countersigned by the father or guardian. Medical leave application should be accompanied by a medical certificate.
- D)** Leave of absence will be entirely at the student's own risk and certificate of any kind will not condone a deficiency in attendance required by the university.
- E)** All students including scheduled cast. Scheduled tribes, VJ, NT etc. and economically backward classes getting scholarship or free studentship or free ship should note that their scholarship or free ship will entirely depend on their regular attendance which should not be less than 75% and satisfactory progress as evidence by passing all unit/monthly tests and tests examination of the college. If students belonging to aforesaid categories failed to put in 75% attendance in any month, they will have to pay fees for that month irrespective of the ground of absence.
- F)** Students who failed to put in 75% attendance at lectures and practical classes at the end of session will be detained and will not be allowed to take the university examination irrespective of the grounds of short attendance, as per para 6-A (i) of ordinance 6 of the Nagpur University for degree students.
- The A.T.K.T. students should note that the above conditions of 75% attendance are also application to them.

10. PHYSICAL EFFICIENCY TEST

All students on the role of the college shall present themselves for physical efficiency test before the board of examiners on such date and time as may be fixed by the principal.

Physical Efficiency test shall be conducted in the month of January/ February every year.

Candidate successful at the physical efficiency test, shall be placed in grade A and B and receive certificate signed by the principal. Incentive marks will be awarded to active participates in the intercollegiate tournaments. Attendance 80% must in the regular physical education practical lecture. If a student fails to appear at the physical efficiency test, he/she shall be fined Rs. 50/-.

11. MEDICAL EXAMINATION

Every degree college student on the rolls of college must presents for medical inspection before the medical board appointed by the college. The medical examination is compulsory for all degree college students. The timetable of this examination will be put up on the notice board.

12. COLLEGE EXAMINATION

The home examination, unit test, terminal and test of the college will be held on the dates fixed by the college council. Every student must appear at all the examinations. Absentees without prior permission will have to pay a fine of Rs.50/- per paper.

Students securing marks less than 20% will be fined Rs.10/- for per paper.

The following Categories of the student may get exemption as per the rules made by the college council.

- i) Students appearing at the winter examination of Nagpur University on production of proof to that effect before the commencement of the home examination.
- ii) Student who, on medical ground requests exemption should produce a medical certificate from any one of the medical officers appointed by the college.
- iii) Any other ground which in the opinion of the principal enables the student to claim exemption.

13. NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS)

A unit of NSS is allotted by the University to this College. It endeavors to inculcate among the student self discipline and a sense of Service to humanity. Interested students may contact Dr. S. D. Raibole. The incentive marks will be awarded to active participants.

14. GENERAL DISCIPLINE

All the students of the college should observe the rules of conduct by the college council. These rules are given for the information and guidance of the students under schedule B.

SCHEDULE – B

Rules of conduct for students:

The following rules have been framed for maintenance of discipline for the students of this college.

- 1) Students shall have to obey all orders of the principal either special or customary. They will be directly answerable him or their behavior in general both inside and outside the college. The names of such students as will be found breaking rules of the college roll. It will be taken for granted on admission that the student concerned, their parents and / or guardian have read and concurred with these rules.
- 2) Students should behave respectfully with all the staff of the college and politely with their fellow students including girls. Any act of disobedience, improper and discourteous exchange of the words or passing of indecent remarks especially at the girl students is a punishable offence and will be views seriously.
- 3) Smoking in the college premises and chewing in the classroom is strictly prohibited.
- 4) Students desiring to go on leave shall have to submit their leave application to the college office in advance before the commencement of the leave period.

The leave application on medical grounds especially at the time of the college examination will be treated as invalid if not accompanied by medical certificate from the doctor.

- 5) Students should specially see that they use college books, Room furniture, Fans, Laboratory equipments and the college properly in general, most carefully. The cost of damage had done to it would be recoverable from the students either individually or collectively as the case may be.
- 6) Only special notices shall be read out in classroom. Students therefore, should see the notice board daily and keep themselves well informed of the various notices which may be put up there from time to time.
- 7) Any change either in the local or permanent address of the students should be informed to the admission clerk so that normal contact with him/ her is not interrupted.
- 8) On admission every student paying Rs.5/- should obtain from the college office an identity / admission card carrying his/ her own passport size photograph duly pasted on it and preserve this card carefully with him/her in order to produce it on demand as and when required.
- 9) No student shall directly send anything concerning the college for publication either to press or elsewhere without the prior approval of and the necessary permission from the principal of the college or shall approach the president or the C.D.C. Members except through the college principal. Any breach of these rules may lead to outright expulsion of the student from the college.
- 10) Students are not authorized to form unions or societies in the college without the prior concern of the principal. They shall also not invite guests or arrange function on their own initiatives.
- 11) No excursions or tours will be arranged by the students without the prior permission of the principal. The attention of the parents/ guardians is specially invited to the fact that they should not permit their sons/ daughters/ wards to take part in the tour unless a letter to that effect is issued by the principal.

- 12) Any breach of the above rules will amount to an often punishable according to the degrees of its seriousness. The punishment will be given by the principal and his decision in the matter shall be final.
- 13) The principal reserves to himself the right to remove from the college roll, the name of any students for -
- i) Failure to pay the college dues.
 - ii) Failure to come up to the academic Standard.
(Progress & Attendance)
 - iii) Conduct, which in the opinion of the principal is unsatisfactory.
- 14) The college has dress code which will be provided by College at minimum charges.
